General Job Description

The core mission of the assembly specialist is to efficiently and accurately assemble components and materials in accordance with plans and specifications and as directed by others. Successful applicant understands written and verbal instruction and can understand and follow drawings and work instruction. Candidate can operate all-non-specialized shop equipment as well as hand and power tools. Candidate will work with metal cladding, insulation and steel components. Candidate is skilled in material handling, mechanical assembly, and maintains a safe work environment through organization and housekeeping.

- Competent in a trade and able to apply these skills to multiple tasks.
- Reads and interprets drawings and work instruction.
- Selects the proper tool for the tasks and ensures proper operation.

Physical Requirements

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.
